A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COTTONWOOD, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE PRELIMINARY STEPS TO BE TAKEN TO BECOME A PARTICIPATING EMPLOYER IN THE PUBLIC SAFETY PERSONNEL RETIREMENT SYSTEM ON BEHALF OF THE FULL-TIME FIREMEN OF THE TOWN OF COTTONWOOD, ARIZONA.

Mayor Hahn stated that this resolution would allow the new Fire Chief to be enrolled in the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System. Councilman Wills then moved to adopt Resolution Number 818. Motion was seconded by Councilman Brown and carried unanimously.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 819 - Appointment to Cottonwood Board of Adjustment

Mayor Hahn requested the Town Manager to read Resolution Number 819 by title only, inserting the name of Robert B. Merrill:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF COTTONWOOD, ARIZONA, APPOINTING ROBERT B. MERRILL TO THE TOWN OF COTTONWOOD BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND ESTABLISHING HIS TERM OF OFFICE.

Councilman Moen moved to adopt Resolution Number 819. Motion was seconded by Councilman Lewis and carried unanimously.

PAYMENT OF ATTORNEY FEES - Price Lawsuit

Mayor Hahn stated that regarding the lawsuit of Price vs. the Town of Cottonwood, attorney fees incurred by the Plaintiffs amounted to \$2,683.75. Councilman Lewis moved to pay the attorney fees in that amount as stipulated in the settlement. Motion was seconded by Councilman Moen and carried unanimously.

ARIZONA STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM

Mayor Hahn stated that the Town notified the Arizona State Retirement System two years ago that the Town no longer wanted to participate in the system. Mayor Hahn then moved that a letter be written to the Arizona State Retirement System requesting that all employee and Town contributions be returned to the Town with interest at the earliest possible date. Motion was seconded by Councilman Moen and carried unanimously. The Town Manager stated that an employee meeting was scheduled for the next morning to discuss the situation with Town employees.

CONSIDERATION OF GUIDELINES - Airport/Industrial Park Lease

Councilman Snyder moved to advertise for bids for the leasing of the Airport/Industrial Park, using the guidelines as presented by staff. Councilman Lewis seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

CLAIMS

After discussion, Councilman Lewis moved to pay the claims as money is available. Motion was seconded by Councilman Brown and carried unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business before the Council, Councilman Moen moved to adjourn.
