REQUEST TO SERVE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES - Verde Valley Chamber of Commerce

Mayor Hahn stated that a request had been received from the Verde Valley Chamber of Commerce to serve alcoholic beverages during their annual Las Vegas Night to be held Saturday, May 7 in the Cottonwood Civic Center.
