

ORDINANCE NUMBER 711

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE DOCUMENT TITLED "CHANGES TO THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD ZONING ORDINANCE, DATED APRIL 14, 2022."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:


**Section 1:** That certain document known as the "Changes to the City of Cottonwood Zoning Ordinance, dated April 14, 2022," three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Cottonwood, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution Number 3124 of the City of Cottonwood, Arizona is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.

**Section 2:** All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance or any part of the code adopted herein by reference are hereby repealed.

**Section 3:** City Staff are hereby authorized and directed to renumber, as necessary and appropriate, any section or sections of the above-described revision and/or the City of Cottonwood Zoning Ordinance as amended.

**Section 4:** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance or any part of the code adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.


