

ORDINANCE NUMBER 710

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD, ARIZONA, AMENDING SECTION 2.110.040. D. OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATING TO THE ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERS OF THE CITY'S HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cottonwood, Arizona has determined that it is reasonable, appropriate and in the public interest to make certain changes to the City's Municipal Code as more fully described below.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Chapter 2.110 - Historic Preservation, Section 2.110.040. D., is hereby amended by deleting Section 2.110.040. D. in its entirety and adding a new Section 2.110.040. D., as follows:

2.110.040 - Membership.

D. A member absent from three regular meetings or a cumulative total of five regular or special meetings within a calendar year shall constitute the constructive resignation of that member, and said vacancy shall be filled by the city council, with the option that said member may apply in writing to the city council for consideration of reinstatement. The council may remove any member of the commission by a majority vote of the council or as otherwise provided by this Code.

Section 2. Severability: That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance adopted herein is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such a decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
