

ORDINANCE NUMBER 736

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD, ARIZONA, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD, ARIZONA, BY REPEALING AND REPLACING SECTION 14.04.010 OF TITLE 14, CHAPTER 14.04 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE APPLICABILITY OF SEWER OR SEPTIC FEES.

WHEREAS, on or about May 6, 2014, the Cottonwood City Council adopted Title 14 of the Cottonwood City Code entitled *City Utilities* pursuant to Ordinance Number 605; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary and appropriate to amend Section 14.04.010 of Title 14, Chapter 14.04, entitled *Approved Sewer or Septic System Required* so that henceforth only properties connected to the City of Cottonwood's wastewater collection and treatment system are subject to sewer customer fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That Section 14.04.010 APPROVED SEWER OR SEPTIC SYSTEM REQUIRED of the City of Cottonwood's Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting the section in its entirety and adding a new Section 14.04.010, as follows:

14.04.010 - Approved sewer or septic system required.

The customer shall obtain and maintain a connection to an approved sewer or septic system prior to being provided potable water. All properties that are connected to the city's wastewater collection and treatment system are subject to the sewer customer fees established by the City Council.

Section 2. That if any section, subsection, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions hereof.




