

MINOR LAND DIVISION & LOT LINE ADJUSTMENT APPLICATION

Minor Land Division is division of improved or unimproved land whose area is two and one-half acres or less into two (2) or three (3) lots, tracts or parcels of land for the purpose of sale or lease, and which does not involve a new street, shall be subject to the provisions of this Article.

Lot Line Adjustment is an adjustment of a common boundary line between parcels which does not result in a net gain in the number of lots or parcels.
